1. The petitioners through instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondent to give them joining letter alongwith notional benefits.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that as per instructions dated 20.01.1988 issued by Chief Secretary of Haryana, the waiting list cannot remain in force for a period beyond one year. In the instant case, the selection process concluded on 16.01.2024, thus, waiting list became inoperative on 15.01.2024. Nevertheless, the respondent has requested Chief Secretary to grant permission to operate waiting list beyond one year. If the permission is accorded by Chief Secretary, the competent authority would consider claim of the petitioners in accordance with law.

3. Ms. Sukriti Kaur, learned counsel for the petitioners agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of. Let the needful be done expeditiously.
