The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the FIR no.214 dated 04.10.2024, under Sections 132, 221, 351 (2), 224 and 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala, Annexure P-2; FIR no.224 dated 16.10.2024, under Sections 221, 109, 132, 191 (3) and 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 132 and 134 of the Representation of Peoples Act, 1951 and 1988, Annexure P-7; and FIR no.225 dated 16.10.2024, under Sections 132, 221 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala, Annexure P-11.

2. Learned State counsel contends that during pendency of the petition charge has been framed against the petitioner in two cases, i.e., FIR nos.224 and 225 and the matters are pending trial.



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3. In view thereof, the petition stands disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to take all the pleas taken herein during trial.
