1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.180 dated 02.08.2025 registered under Sections 115(2), 81, 351(2), 74, 127(2) & 69 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Sadar, District Kapurthala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted ad interim anticipatory bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-1, Kapurthala vide order dated 13.08.2025, however, the said anticipatory bail has been rejected by the same Court, vide order dated 15.09.2025. He further submits that now the matter has been compromised between the parties vide compromise deed dated 20.09.2025 (Annexure P-4) and he wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Sessions Court for grant of anticipatory bail in view of the change of circumstances i.e. compromise effected between the parties.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
