The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release withheld annual increments and pay the arrears to the petitioners with effect from 2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case they are permitted to make a fresh representation before respondent no.4 raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amit Sahni, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3/State and on the asking of the Court, he also accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.4/Parishad. He submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners within two weeks from today, the same will be decided by respondent no.4/State Project Director, Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, by passing a speaking

order in accordance with law within a period of three months of receiving the representation.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
