The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case FIR No.230 dated 02.06.2024 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC (Sections 326 & 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station, Civil Lines, Kaithal, District Kaithal.

On 05.12.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner is identically placed as co-accused Rohit Monga who has since been extended the concession of interim bail by this Court vide order dated 06.09.2024. It has been submitted that the petitioner was neither named in the FIR in question nor any specific role had been attributed to him. The petitioner came to be nominated as an accused subsequently in

a supplementary statement made by the injured Mandeep Singh. It has still further been submitted that even in the CCTV footage retrieved from the place of occurrence, the petitioner was not visible. Learned counsel has still further drawn the attention of this Court to Annexure P-2 which is an affidavit given by Sonu (complainant) to the effect that the petitioner was not involved in the occurrence in question.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 05.12.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 05.12.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
