HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside impugned order dated 31.10.2023 (Annexure P-8) passed by learned Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala, whereby the order dated 09.10.2020 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Yamunanagar and order dated 18.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) in respect of Mutation No.1573 of Village Mandhar, was set aside.

2. During the course of hearing of the instant writ petition, learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing for respondents No.5 and 6 have arrived at a consensus that the order dated 31.10.2023 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala and also the orders i.e. order dated 09.10.2020 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned



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Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Yamunanagar and order dated 18.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned Collector, Yamunanagar be set aside and the matter be remanded to the learned Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Yamunanagar for deciding the mutation No.1573 afresh, on the basis of Civil Court Decree dated 07.03.1998 (Annexure P-3), as per law.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid broad consensus between learned counsels for respective parties, the impugned order dated 31.10.2023 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala and also the order dated 09.10.2020 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Yamunanagar along with order dated 18.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned Collector, Yamunanagar on Mutation No.1573 are set aside and the matter is remitted to the learned Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Yamunanagar for deciding the mutation afresh on the basis of Civil Court Decree dated 07.03.1998 (Annexure P-3) and also taking into consideration the law as regards declaratory decrees are concerned, within a period of three months from the date of appearance of the parties before him, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties.

4. The parties are directed to appear before the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Yamunanagar on 08.09.2025.

5. The present writ petition is disposed of accordingly, in aforesaid terms.

6. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
