1. The petitioners have filed the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents to pay to the petitioners, who are recruited as Teachers through Direct Recruitment, full salary in pay band, with grade pay, all allowances including dearness allowances, during the 2/3 year period of probation alongwith arrears and interest and also to treat such probation period towards permanent service for all the intents and purposes, including for the purpose of grant of increments and seniority for the said period.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 09.01.2025 (Annexure P-8) to the official respondents and he shall be satisfied in case, appropriate directions are issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 09.01.2025 (Annexure P-8).

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG,

Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, at this stage.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. At this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 09.01.2025 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioners, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking and well reasoned order. In case, petitioners are found entitled to any consequential benefits, the same shall also be released to them, without any further delay, along with reasonable rate of interest.
