1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.69, dated 28.09.2024, under Sections 419,420,465,467,468,471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Block Majri, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P-1).

2. Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant by filing his Vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.02.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. On the other hand learned counsel for the complainant submits that he has no objection, if the present petition is allowed as the matter has been

settled with the petitioner and the complainant has received an amount of Rs.10,00,000/- from him.

6. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 06.02.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
