1. The detenue, Ms. Riya, has been produced by respondent No.5. She has been sent to the General Counsellor, namely Ms. Neharika Malik. She has stated before the aforesaid counsellor as well as before this Court that, although she had accompanied the present petitioner on 23.09.2025 for consulting some counsel as she had been trying to marry the petitioner, however, she had thereafter gone with the private respondents of her own free will on that day. She has further stated that the petitioner had not taken her along by exerting any force. She has, however, expressed her desire to stay with her parents only, at this stage.
2. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
