1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.81, dated 18.06.2024, under Sections 406, 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Mullanpur, District Mohali (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.03.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and also submits that the matter has been settled between the parties.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant also submits that he has no objection, in case the present petition is allowed by this

Court as the matter has been settled between the parties and the entire payment has been made by the petitioner.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 05.03.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
