1. The petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P-7) in view of Section 34 (2) of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and fill up 03 backlog vacancies of physically handicapped category from persons other than persons with disabilities.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P-7) to the respondents No.1 and 2 and he shall be satisfied in case, appropriate directions are issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned

counsel for the petitioner, at this stage.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. At this stage, it would be appropriate to direct the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P-7) within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. While passing the order, respondent No.2 shall take into consideration the provisions of Section 34 (2) of Persons with Disabilities Act,2016.

7. It is expected that respondent No.2 shall pass a speaking and well reasoned order and in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any relief, all consequential benefits may also be allowed to him, without any further delay, along with reasonable rate of interest.
