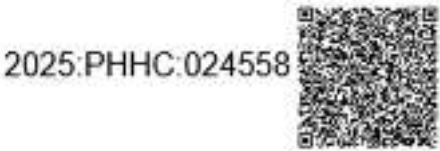

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh, who is present in Court, has submitted that vide Special Report dated 14.01.2025 submitted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, a member of the Special Investigation Team (SIT), the appellant has been declared innocent in the instant FIR No.177 dated 05.09.2023, under Section 346 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (*Sections 365, 506 read with 34 & 120-B IPC added subsequently*); and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989; registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, vide General Diary No.018 dated 14.01.2025, Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda. A copy of the proceedings has been supplied to learned counsel for the appellant.
