1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No. 391 dated 12.09.2023 registered under Sections 324, 506, 148, 149 & 326, 323, 307 (added later on) of IPC, at Police Station Gobindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Vide order dated 14.05.2025, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Magistrate for getting their statements recorded with respect to the compromise dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-2).

3. Pursuant to aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khadur Sahib, Tarn Taran and got their statements recorded. Report dated 14.07.2025 has been received whereby after recording the statements of the parties, the Court below has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in the present case, the injury suffered by the injured has been declared to be grievous in nature and the offence under Section 307 IPC has been wrongly added in the present case.

5. Learned State counsel also does not dispute the said submission.

6. I have heard counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

7. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court below and considering the offence for which the accused have been charged are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences for betterment of future life of the parties and also in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the present petition for quashing the FIR is allowed qua the petitioners.

8. Resultantly, FIR No. 391 dated 12.09.2023 registered under Sections 324, 506, 148, 149 & 326, 323, 307 (added later on) of IPC, at Police Station Gobindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
