Main case

Instant petition under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik
Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS) has been preferred seeking directions to
the official respondent No. 2 to ensure fair investigation of the FIR
(Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner happened to be the complainant in case FIR (*supra*) registered way back on 17.08.2023 and till date there has not been any headway in the investigation even despite the anticipatory bail applications filed by the alleged accused have been dismissed in January 2024. He submits that the petitioner had moved a representation dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P-5) to the Deputy Inspector General, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur, but till date no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice and submits that the aforesaid representation shall be considered and disposed of expeditiously in accordance with the law.

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7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Deputy Inspector General, Ferozepur Range, Ferozepur, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P-5), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
