The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case FIR No.101 dated 16.10.2024 under Sections 118(1), 118(2), 115(2), 191(3) and 190 of BNSS, 2023 (section 118(2) of BNS, 2023 added later on), registered at Police Station, Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

On 04.12.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and asked them to join investigation:-

“Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Amandeep, has not disputed that in the occurrence in question a DDR had been recorded at the instance of the accused party herein and the complainant party had inflicted an injury on the

head of one Jashanpreet Singh (from the accused party) which was opined to be dangerous to life. It has also not been disputed that the petitioners have been attributed only a simple injury on the person of Navneet Singh.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 04.12.2024, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04.12.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
