1. Petitioner has filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.249 dated 29.07.2017, under Section 379 of IPC (later on added in challan Section 473, 411 of IPC), registered at Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh, in view of compromise vide Annexure P-3 effected between respondent No.2/complainant and petitioner/accused.
