NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.648 dated 06.09.2020 registered under Sections 380 & 457 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Hisar Sadar, District Hisar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom including final report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C. dated 19.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) presented against the petitioner under Section 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012 and Sections 354(A)(1)(i), 380, 457 & 506 of IPC on the basis of compromise/settlement agreement dated 23.09.2025 (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder, submits that there is a concealment on the part of the petitioner as the



petitioner is also involved in 03 other cases which fact has not been mentioned in the present petition. The particulars of those three cases are as under :-

Sr. No.	Particulars
1.	FIR No.281 dated 10.03.2022 registered under Sections 323, 506 & 34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Hisar.
2.	FIR No.691 dated 28.06.2023 registered under Sections 323, 341 & 506 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Hisar.
3.	FIR No.824 dated 27.11.2020 registered under Sections 457 & 380 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Hisar.

3. Learned State counsel further submits that the trial in the instant case is at the advance stage and is fixed for defence evidence.
4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
