1. This petition for grant of interim bail under Section 483 BNSS, has been filed by petitioner, a co-accused in case bearing FIR No.195 dated 19.07.2025, registered against him at Police Station Anti Narcotics Force, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, for the commission of offences punishable u/s 21(c), 25 of NDPS Act, on the ground that the marriage of his sister is scheduled to take place on 27.09.2025.

2. Briefly stating the facts emerging from record are that the petitioner is facing trial for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 21(c), 25 of NDPS Act, and he is in custody in the aforesaid case.

3. On advance notice, Mr. Gautam Thapar, Sr. DAG, Punjab and Mr. Manmeet Singh, AAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondent-State, on



instructions of ASI Kulbir Singh, submits that the facts stand duly verified to the effect that marriage of sister of petitioner is scheduled to be held on 27.09.2025.

4. In view of above mentioned facts and circumstances, since the petitioner, being real brother, is supposed to attend the marriage of his sister, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and the petitioner is admitted to interim bail for a period of one week, i.e. from 27.09.2025 till 03.10.2025, subject to the condition of his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on 03.10.2025 at 5.00 P.M.
