1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents and their accomplices, who are threatening and harassing the petitioner and his family members and to consider and decide representation dated 25.09.2025 (Annexure P-5) filed by petitioner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. G.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and assures that respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali would look into the representation dated 25.09.2025 (Annexure P-5).



4. In view of the above, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to look into the representation and decide the same on the basis of threat perception felt by the petitioner and if the threat perception is found to be true then the protection as admissible in law shall be provided. In case, the concerned SSP is of the view that no protection is required, then a speaking order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.
5. Disposed of.
6. Pending misc. application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
