CWP-32419-2024 was disposed of vide order dated 02.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) with a direction to respondent No.2 therein to consider and decide the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 17.07.2024 in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months.

2. The instant contempt petition alleges disobedience of the said order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel representing the State of Haryana has furnished a copy of the speaking order which already stood passed on 17.03.2025 in compliance with the directions issued vide order dated 17.07.2024 (ibid). The same is taken on record as Mark X and a copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no grievance subsists and the petitioner shall, if so advised, avail all such remedies as shall be admissible in law against the said order.

5. Accordingly, the present contempt petition is disposed of in terms of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner. Rule stands discharged.
