The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, seeks issuance of directions to the Court of Additional District Judge-cum-Land Acquisition Tribunal, Nawanshahr (Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar) to decide the claim filed under Section 3-H of the National Highways Act, 1956 (**for short “the Act”**) in LAC Case No. 02 of 2022, titled “*Kashmir Singh Versus Sandeep Kumar etc.*”, in a time bound manner.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, submits that the petitioners-landowners are awaiting release of compensation qua their land which was acquired vide Notification dated 04.08.2016 issued under Section 3-A of the Act; thus, prayer is for direction to the Court concerned for deciding the aforesaid case in a time bound manner.

[3] Notice of motion *qua* respondent No. 2 only.

[4] On asking of the Court, Mr. Siddharath Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice and waives services on behalf of respondent No. 2.

[5] I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

[6] Considering the innocuous prayer made in the present petition and also the fact the land came to be acquired in the present case vide Notification dated 04.08.2016 issued under Section 3-A of the Act, the Court below is requested to decide / dispose off the aforementioned case as expeditiously as possible, as per law.

[8] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
