SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Mr. Deepanshu Mehta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 through the medium of video conferencing and has filed Vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

2. In compliance of the previous order, a copy of speaking order bearing No.Civil Division/2025/5493 dated 28.11.2025 has been placed on record. A perusal of the speaking order shows that respondents have



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admitted that balance payment due to petitioner is Rs.5,89,801/- and liquidated damages @ 5% on the work done with effect from 01.02.2022 to 09.11.2022 have been deducted. According to the respondents, an amount of Rs.3,46,857/- is due, which is subject to clearance from third party audit.

3. Counsel for respondents No.2 and 3-Punjab Health System Corporation, states that the third party audit shall be concluded within a period of three months and amount found due to petitioner shall be released within a period of one month thereafter.

4. On the basis of the statement made on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3, writ petition is disposed of.

5. Liberty is granted to petitioner to assail deduction of liquidated damages from the payment due, by taking recourse to the remedy available to it in accordance with law.
