1. Case has been called twice, however, even on second call, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

2. Vide order dated 18.02.2025, the parties were directed to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate and got their statements recorded with respect to the compromise so effected. A report has since been received from the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Zira. A perusal of the report reveals that both the petitioners are proclaimed offenders, which fact had been withheld from this Court while filing the instant petition. Learned State counsel has also, on instructions, submitted that the petitioners are proclaimed offenders and hence, the instant petition deserves to be dismissed on this ground as well as on the ground of misrepresentation/concealment of material fact before this Court.

3. In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed.
