JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing respondents No.1 & 2 to appoint the Administrator in Swati Co-operative Society, Chandigarh as per the mandate of Section 26(1-C) and 26(1-D) of the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act, 1961 and also to set aside the letter (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.4.

2. At the outset, Ms. Priyanka Kansal, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 to 3-U.T., Chandigarh has submitted that on 21.07.2025, an order has been passed by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, U.T., Chandigarh whereby an Administrator has been appointed in the aforesaid Society and therefore, the present petition has become infructuous. She has also supplied a copy of the aforesaid order dated 21.07.2025 in the

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Court today, which is hereby taken on record as mark 'X'. The Registry is directed to tag the aforesaid order at an appropriate place and also paginate the same.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the aforesaid order (Mark 'X') passed by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, U.T., Chandigarh, the present petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. Disposed of as having become infructuous.

5. So far as the application bearing number CM-1622-CWP-2024 which has been filed by Mr. R.S. Arya, Advocate for impleadment of the Society as respondent in the present case is concerned, considering the fact that the present petition has been disposed of as having become infructuous because an Administrator has been appointed, no further orders are required to be passed in the aforesaid application for impleadment of the Society in the present case.

6. However, in case, the applicant has any remedy available to it in accordance with law, then the applicant/Society can always avail the same by filing any appropriate application/petition before the appropriate authority but strictly in accordance with law.
