1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 26.07.2024 (Annexure P-3), passed by Director, Village Development and Panchayat, Punjab and report dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) of District Panchayat and Development Officer, Sangrur.

2. On 21.11.2024, following order was passed :-

*“ Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are certain inadvertent errors in the translation of Annexure P-3, therefore he seeks a short accommodation to place on record the correct translation of Annexure P-3.
