SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 11.09.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-24728-2019.

2. The relevant portion of order dated 11.09.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-24728-2019 is reproduced as under:-

“4. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondents to decide representation dated 06.05.2024, Annexure P-1, expeditiously, in accordance with law.”

3. In compliance of the above order, reply dated 31.07.2024 by way of affidavit of Dr. Pawan Kumar, CHC Dadlana, Panipat was filed on behalf of respondent No. 4 stating therein that speaking order dated 27.11.2024 was passed by Civil Surgeon, Panipat. The copy of speaking order dated 27.11.2024 has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners in this Court on 28.11.2024.



4. In view of the above, order dated 11.09.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-24728-2019 has already been complied with. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

5. Accordingly, the contempt is purged. Rule is *discharged*.

6. Needless to say that petitioners can avail any other remedy as is available to them, in accordance with law, to challenge the speaking order dated 27.11.2024 was passed by Civil Surgeon, Panipat.
