1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.109 dated 06.10.2024, under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station North (Sector-3), District Chandigarh.

2. Vide order dated 10.12.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 10.12.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Pal, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

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5. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the complainant.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 10.12.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
