Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.271 dated 19.09.2024 registered under Section 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Sushant Lok, District Gurugram.

2. On the last date of hearing, it was brought to the notice of this Court that the parties have effected the compromise on account of which the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the Police.

3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised



this Court that in light of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the Police. He further submits that the compromise which was effected between the parties has also been acted upon and the entire settlement is already paid to the complainant.

4. Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant, who is appearing through VC, has not disputed the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner. He has also admitted the factum of compromise.

5. State counsel on instructions from SI Vinod Kumar submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for the purpose of further investigation by the Police.

6. In light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 20.12.2024 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
