1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-9) vide which respondent No. 6 (Sahnaz) was reinstated on the post of Sarpanch.

2. In pursuance of advance copy of petition having been served upon respondent-State, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG Haryana appears and files copy of order dated 29.10.2024, passed by Deputy Commissioner, Nuh, in Court today, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

3. Learned State counsel, while referring to Annexure P-9, submits that vide order dated 22.08.2024, respondent No. 6 was ordered to be reinstated pending inquiry till further orders. It is submitted that the inquiry against respondent No. 6 already stands concluded and fresh order dated 29.10.2024 has been passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Nuh, whereby it has been concluded that the allegations against respondent No. 6 for contesting election on the basis of wrong educational qualification has not been proved and accordingly, respondent No. 6 (Sahnaz) has been ordered to be reinstated.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to avail his remedy against the order dated 29.10.2024, as available to the petitioner, in accordance with law.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Pending applications(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
