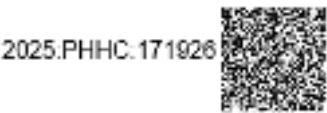

YASHVIR SINGH RATHOR, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for quashing of FIR No.0031 dated 10.07.2009, under Sections 323, 341, 342, 506, 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala and for quashing of the order dated 11.02.2011, whereby, petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated 17.10.2025 passed by this Court, status report by way of an affidavit dated 27.11.2025 of Karnail Singh, PPS Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Bholath, District Kapurthala filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.

3. This Court vide order dated 17.10.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send his/her report qua



the genuineness of the compromise.

4. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kapurthala and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 21.10.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

5. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

6. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served by continuing with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 titled as '*Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another*' and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2012) 10 SCC 303 titled as '*Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others*'. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the FIR No.0031 dated 10.07.2009, under Sections 323, 341, 342, 506, 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala and for quashing of the order dated 11.02.2011, whereby, petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.
