1. Through the instant writ petition, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to transfer the petitioner (who is presently lodged in Central Jail, Kapurthala), to Central Jail, Amritsar or Central Jail, Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

2. Two short affidavits dated 20.01.2025 of Mr. Hemant Sharma, Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar, on behalf of the respondents No.2 and 3, and affidavit of Ms. Shyamal Jyoti, Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala, on behalf of the respondents No.2 to 5, furnished by the learned State counsel today in the Court. The same are taken on the record.

3. As per the affidavit (supra), the present petitioner has already been transferred from Central Jail, Kapurthala, to Central Jail, Amritsar, on dated 19.01.2025, vide order dated 15.01.2025, passed by Additional Director

General of Police (Jails), Punjab, Chandigarh.

4. In view of the above, the prayer made in the instant writ petition has become infructuous. Consequently, the instant writ petition **is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.**
