Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking setting aside of impugned orders dated 10.11.2014 (Annexure P-4), 25.03.2015 (Annexure P-6), 10.02.2020 (Annexure P-12), 04.03.2023 (Annexure P-16), 29.09.2023 (Annexure P-21) passed by learned trial Court and orders/judgments dated 05.02.2016 (Annexure P-8), 22.08.2022 (Annexure P-14), 08.11.2024 (Annexure P-18 and P-23) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak vide which various applications moved under Sections 173(8), 190, 311, 319, 210 of Cr.P.C. were dismissed by the trial Court and the revisions against the orders were dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak in case bearing FIR No. 206 dated 23.04.2012 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Civil Lines Rohtak in criminal case bearing CIS No. CHI/154/2014.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that trial of the case has already concluded and private respondents have been acquitted on 04.01.2025 as such, nothing survives in the present petition and the same



has been rendered infructuous. Therefore, he wishes to withdraw the present petition.

3. In view of the above, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn as having been rendered infructuous.
