1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.506 dated 15.10.2024, registered under Sections 115, 117(2), 126 and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (Section 109 of BNS, 2023 added later on), at Police Station Kurukshetra University, District Kurukshetra.

2. By virtue of order dated 28.11.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Randhir Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.11.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
