1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, Act 2023 is for quashing of FIR No.214 dated 12.04.20224 under Sections 420, 406 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Hansi City, District Hansi, Haryana (Annexure P-1) along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 22.11.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. The following order was passed on 10.12.2024:

“Petitioner has filed petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.214 dated 12.04.2024 under Sections 420 and 406 of IPC, 1860 (P-1) registered at Police Station Hansi City, District Hansi, Haryana along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 22.11.2024 (P-2).

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rupinder Singh Jhand, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State and prays for time to file status report. Learned counsel for petitioner is directed to supply him a complete copy of the paperbook.

Mr. S.K. Bishnoi, Advocate appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 3, which is taken on record.

Let statements of petitioner and respondent Nos.2 and 3 be recorded with regard to the compromise, on or before 08.01.2025 by learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate concerned, as per the convenience of said Court. In the event of their statements being recorded, the Court will send copies of the same to this Court before the next date of hearing along with its report i.e

1. The number of accused in aforesaid FIR and to report whether any of the accused has been declared proclaimed offender(s) or any such proceedings have been initiated or pending against him.

2. Whether the compromise entered between the parties is genuine, voluntary without any coercion or undue influence.

3. Statement of IO regarding involvement of petitioner in any other FIR.

4. Status of the trial pending before the Court. To await the report, list again on 31.01.2025.

Status report be also filed by respondent – State by adjourned date. “

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and**

another, (2014) 6 SCC 466 and Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63 and Full Bench of this Court in Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052, this petition is allowed and FIR No.214 dated 12.04.20224 under Sections 420, 406 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Hansi City, District Hansi, Haryana (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, *qua* the petitioner.
