SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 16.05.2024, passed by this Court in CWP-10616-2024.
2. While deciding CWP-10616-2024 on 16.05.2024, this Court directed the respondents to decide legal notices dated 01.01.2024 and 26.02.2024, expeditiously.
3. Mr. Aditya Sharda, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 to 5 and filed his vakalatnama, which is taken on record. He contends that in compliance of order dated 16.05.2024 and order dated 17.12.2024 has been passed. Copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner and also placed on record.



4. A perusal of order dated 17.12.2024, passed by respondent-University, shows that order dated 16.05.2024, passed by this Court in CWP-10616-2024, has been complied with. This fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, the civil original contempt petition is disposed of. The contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
