The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction especially in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detenue Annu w/o the petitioner, who is illegally detained by respondents No.5 to 8.

The affidavit of the State shows that the alleged detenue is living with her parents and she has also categorically stated that she is living with her parental family as per her own wishes and without any pressure of any person.

In the light of above, no cause of action survives in the present petition. Hence the same is disposed off, as having been rendered infructuous.
