1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.248 dated 25.04.2024 under Sections 148, 149, 308, 323, 324, 452 & 506 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Industrial Sector 29, Panipat along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 21.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. The following order was passed on 29.11.2024:

*“This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.248 dated 25.04.2024 under Sections 148, 149, 308, 323, 324, 452 & 506 IPC registered at Police Station Industrial Sector 29, Panipat along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 21.11.2024 (Annexure P2) arrived at between the parties.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Ms. Sonia Bohat, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 & 3 and has*



*filed her vakalatnama. The same is taken on record. She has admitted the factum of compromise effected between the parties.*

*The parties are directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqa/Duty Magistrate on 18.12.2024 or any other future date as per its convenience or on request of the parties for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise. The trial Court/Illaqa/Duty Magistrate shall submit the report on or before the next date of hearing. The report be forwarded to this Court specifying the following:-*

- 1. The number of accused arraigned in the FIR and how many have appeared before it and have made statements and whether any accused is absconding/proclaimed person, in the case;*
- 2. The name of the complainant and injured/aggrieved and whether all of them have appeared and made their statements in support of the compromise;*
- 3. The stage of the trial/proceedings pending;*
- 4. If, the compromise is genuine, voluntary and out of free will of the parties;*
- 5. Whether any other criminal case pending against the accused.*

*Report of the trial Court/Illaqa/Duty Magistrate be awaited for 03.02.2025.”*

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466** and **Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63** and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and FIR No.248 dated 25.04.2024 under Sections 148, 149, 308, 323, 324, 452 & 506 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Industrial

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Sector 29, Panipat along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, qua the petitioners.
