Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondent No. 3 to trace out and get release the minor daughter of the petitioners namely Miss Mehar (Detenue) from the forceful custody of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Learned State counsel at the very outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition as a compromise has taken place between the parties and the FIR No. 91 dated 17.08.2024 mentioned in para No. 6 of the instant petition has been quashed by this Court on the basis of compromise vide order dated 04.10.2024 passed in CRM-M-45801-2024. Short reply filed by learned State counsel is already on record.

Further the short reply filed by State of Punjab as well as the short reply filed by the private respondents indicate that an adoption deed was executed on 30.08.2024, which is available on record as Annexure P-4 and as such nothing survives in the present petition.



In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as nothing remains to be adjudicated in the same.
