1. The petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order/letter dated 15.09.2025 (Annexure P-5) qua the petitioner, whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Barnala to Amritsar as Kanungo.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been transferred under political pressure and while transferring him, the transfer policy has been completely overlooked by the respondents. He further contends that wife of the petitioner is working as ANM in the Health Department, Naiwala, District Barnala and two children of the petitioner are also studying in

school at Barnala, which is evident from their Identity Cards (Annexure P-7).

3. At this stage, learned State Counsel, on instructions from Sh. Inderjeet Singh, Junior Assistant, Director, Land Records, Punjab, Jalandhar, submits that the petitioner may be granted liberty to make a representation to respondent No. 2 and the case of the petitioner shall be considered sympathetically. He further contends that in case any representation is moved by the petitioner within period of one week from today, the same shall be considered by respondent No. 2 within a period of one week thereafter.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State Counsel, no further directions are required to be issued and the present petition is accordingly disposed of.
