1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.27 dated 02.04.2024, under Sections 21 and 29 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mamdot, Ferozpur.
2. Vide order dated 28.11.2025, passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail in the same terms as given in connected case i.e. CRM-M-53154 of 2024.
3. Status report dated 14.05.2025 filed on behalf of respondent-State is taken on record.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 05.02.2025 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.



5. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.11.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner in the same terms of the order passed in CRM-M-53154 of 2024, is made absolute, subject to compliance of usual terms and conditions requisite for grant of anticipatory bail.
