1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the official respondents to consider the complaint/representation dated 09.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take necessary action as per law.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 09.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Hoshiarpur-respondent No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Hoshiarpur, to look into representation dated

09.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in
accordance with law.
