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**SANJEEV PRAKASH SHARMA, J. (Oral)**

1.     Learned counsel for the appellant submits that during the pendency of this Appeal, the respondents-State have wrongfully appointed another person as a Sweeper in place of the appellant. Therefore, learned counsel for the appellant prays for withdrawal of the present Appeal with liberty to avail remedy of filing appeal under Section 147 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1994”).

2.     In view of the aforesaid statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the present Appeal is disposed of with observation that if an appeal is filed by the appellant under Section 147 of the Act of 1994 to the



concerned authority under the Act of 1994, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously preferably within a period of four months.

3. All pending applications in this case are disposed of accordingly.
