1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for issuance of passport.

2. Learned senior panel counsel appearing for respondents No. 1 and 2 informs that the passport application of the petitioner already stands closed. She further submits that if the petitioner applies for fresh passport, the same shall be considered by the authorities and appropriate orders will be passed within four weeks from the date such application is filed by the petitioner.
