1. Petitioners seeks anticipatory bail in case arising out of FIR No. 40 dated 23.08.2025 under Sections 316(2), 85 Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Police Station Women Cell, Patiala. This is the first petition for anticipatory bail.

2. Vide order dated 16.10.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners were granted interim bail and were directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh submits that petitioners have joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation. Learned counsel for the complainant, however, opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

4. Petitioners have already joined investigation pursuant to order of this Court dated 16.10.2025 and their further custodial interrogation is not required. In the given facts and circumstances of the case but without commenting on merits, the petition is allowed and order



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dated 16.10.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
