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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 06.03.2024 (Annexure P-4), passed by concerned Deputy Commissioner.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for petitioner submits that in terms of judgment rendered by the Full Bench of this Court in '***Darshan Singh Versus State of Haryana and others***', (CWP-14494-2002, decided on 01.11.2004), the order impugned in this petition would be amenable to appeal before learned Divisional Commissioner concerned, therefore, the petitioner may be permitted to avail his remedy of appeal before learned Divisional Commissioner concerned.

3. Learned State counsel has not raised any objection to the aforesaid course of action to be adopted.
