The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.126, dated 09.08.2024, under Sections 406,420 of IPC and under Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act,2014 and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Division Cantt., Jalandhar, District Jalandhar Commissionerate. (Annexure P-1).

2. A status report by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Cantt), Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.12.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined

the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 02.12.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S/438(2) of Cr.P.C.
