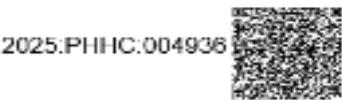

MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under section 528 of the Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2
& 3 to conduct fair and impartial inquiry on the complaint dated 08.11.2024 (P-
3) for registration of FIR against the private respondents for causing multiple
injuries to the son of the petitioner.

(2) Contends that despite repeated asking, police is not taking action in
the matter; hence, direction be issued to the official concerned to proceed in the
matter on the basis of complaint dated 08.11.2024 (P-3).

(3) *Per contra*, Learned State counsel, on instructions, has apprised the
Court that son of the petitioner, namely, Lovepreet Singh is an accused in FIR
No.0112 dated 29.10.2024 under Sections 109, 118(2), 115(2), 191(3) read with
Section 190 of the Bharatiya Nayaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station,
Kathu Nangal; police is trying to join him for ongoing investigation, but he is
evading from the process of law.



- (4) In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present petition “at this stage”.
- (5) Consequently, the same is dismissed.
- (6) Above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the above FIR, in any manner.
- (7) Also clarified that this order be not treated as a bar against availing remedy permissible under law, to the petitioner and/or his son.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
