This is a Contempt Petition filed under Section 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 CPC for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for their willful and intentional disobedience of the order dated 15.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent-State has submitted that in the present case, vide order dated 14.11.2025, the compassionate financial assistance in favour of the petitioner-Smt. Geeta Devi has been restored and has further submitted that the arrears of compassionate financial assistance would be released to the petitioner within a period of 10 days from today.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, the present contempt petition be disposed of but respondents-State be bound by the statement made before this Court.
4. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of. Respondents-State be bound by the statement made before this Court. In case respondents-State backtracks from the said statement, it would be open to the petitioner to file an application for revival of the present contempt petition.
