1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of directions to the respondents to treat the resolution dated 26.06.2023 (Annexure P-4) as inoperative and to permit him to continue in service up to the age of 60 years i.e. w.e.f. 31.05.2023 to 31.05.2025 with all consequential benefits in terms of judgement dated 09.08.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP-16052-2020.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and the same may be decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Vikas Arora, DAG, Punjab appearing for the respondents does not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and decide the same within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law. In case the petitioner is held entitled for the benefit, as claimed by him in the present writ petition, the same be also released to the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of 08 weeks thereafter.
