1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.149 dated 11.11.2024, registered under Sections 303(2), 318(4), 125, 287, 3(5) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2. By virtue of order dated 05.12.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
